

M.Com.Arts Comprehensive Examination (Global Communication)

Comprehensive Examination Guidelines

The Comprehensive Examination is organized only ONE Day from 1.00 – 5.00 pm (4 hours). It consists of a case study that requires students to analyse and apply all bodies of knowledge in theories and applications, specialisation, and research. It is compulsory that students must follow the comprehensive examination instructions strictly and complete all the questions.

Although students are allowed to bring books or documents, those must be in printed forms or hard copies. Other types of books or materials are strictly prohibited.

Students are allowed to take the examination only three times. Failure after the third attempt will result in dismissal from the programme.

The Comprehensive Examination is usually scheduled in August – September, October – November, and April – May of each year.

Remarks : Students who do not register for Comprehensive Examination or for any course(s) in that semester are requested to fill out the leave of absence form and pay a fee of 1,000 baht to maintain their student status.
