Comprehensive Examination Guidelines

1. The Examination consists of a case study that requires students to analyze and apply all bodies of knowledge in theories and applications, specialization, and research.
2. Exam Duration: 4 hours.
3. Students are allowed to bring books or documents (in printed forms or hard copies). Other types of books or materials are strictly prohibited.
4. It is compulsory that students must follow the comprehensive examinations strictly and complete all the questions.
5. Students are allowed to take the examination only three times. Failure after the third attempt will result in dismissal from the program.
6. The Comprehensive Examination are usually scheduled in
 - September - October
 - November - December
 - February - March
 - July – August

Remarks : Students who do not register for Comprehensive Examination or for any course(s) in that semester are requested to fill out the leave of absence form and pay a fee of 1,000 baht to maintain their student status.
